

Knox County - Route 15 add shoulders from Scotland County to Shelby County lines

Why is this a priority for the NEMO TAC?

- The driving lanes on the approximately 30 miles of Route 15 across Knox County are narrow (11' lanes) with little to no shoulder.
- Added to the FY21 and FY22 plans for resurfacing, MoDOT is hoping to add shoulders with funding from the Governor's Backfill Money.

ABOUT THE PROJECT...

- Traffic Volume (ADT) -1,065 - 1,859 north of Edina; 313 - 1,098 south of Edina
- Truck Percentage 12%
- 5-Year accident Rate 67.0 (north) - 88.7 (south) (40 accidents, 9 disabling injury)
