### **Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI**

#### **How to file a Title VI/ADA complaint with NEMO RPC:**

1. A copy of the Complaint Form and the Complaint Procedures be obtained by downloading the documents from NEMO RPC's website at [www.nemorpc.org](http://www.nemorpc.org) and/or by requesting a copy from the Title VI Contact Derek Weber, Executive Director NEMO RPC at 660.465.7281 ext. 1 or [derekweber@nemorpc.org](mailto:derekweber@nemorpc.org).
2. In addition to the complaint process at NEMO RPC, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, East Building, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor – TCR 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE Washington, DC 20590.
3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
4. The form must be signed, dated, and include your contact information.
